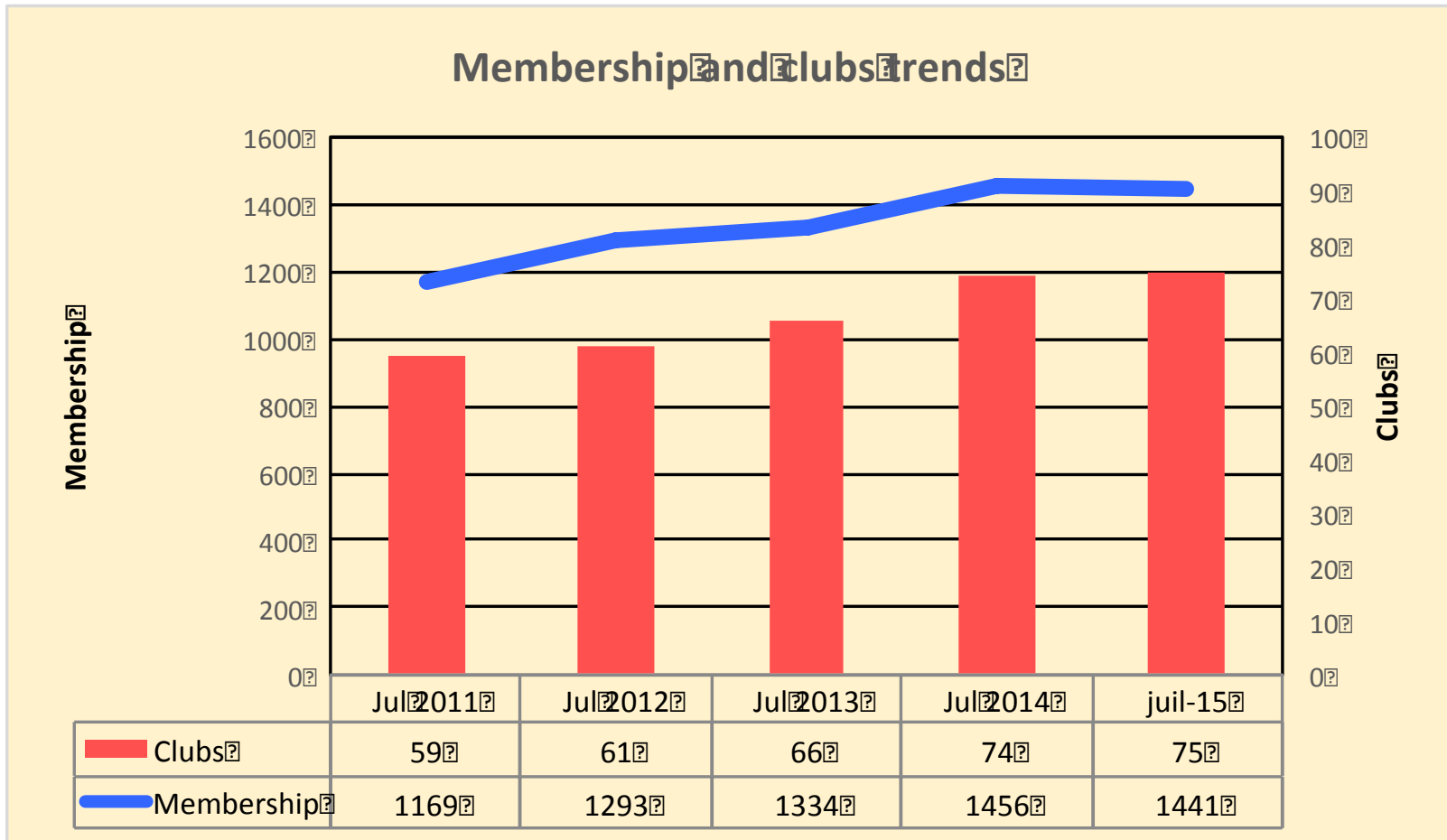

Geographical characteristics



- ✓ 10 countries : Burundi, Cameroon, Congo, Gabon, Equatorial Guinea, CAR, DRC, Rwanda, Sao Tomé & Principe, Chad
- ✓ 135,5 millions d'inhabitants,
- ✓ 5.419 km²
- ✓ More than 5.000 km between north and south

Membership and clubs trends



The year was marked by the **creation of 6 clubs** but the **termination of 5 clubs**

Key figures *(by July 1st 2015)*

Membership and clubs :

- 1.441 members
- 75 clubs

Year 2014-2015 :

- 6 clubs created
- 6 clubs terminated (non payment dues)
- 1 club readmitted

Today's situation

Membership and clubs :

- 1.505 members (+64) (1441 by 01/07/2015)
- 77 clubs (+2) (75 by 01/07/2015)
- Compared to the objective of 6 new clubs by 30/06/2016 : 2 club have been chartered

- Strong and steady increase in Burundi and Gabon
- Stagnation in DRC, Cameroon and Congo

- Burundi, Gabon, DRC and Cameroon create more clubs
- DRC and Cameroon have a relatively weak retention rate

Clubs retention rate

From July 1st 2010 (55 clubs) : +21 clubs

- New clubs : 24 created, 3 terminated, retention rate 91,7%, 1 club readmitted
- Existing Clubs : 24 clubs terminated, retention rate 88,5%, 17 clubs readmitted
- Global clubs retention rate are correct but 1/3 strive to work with 15 members or less

Socio-economic data

The clubs number in a country or a city helps diversity (classification, gender, age) : **51% of the District Rotarians belong to 34 clubs in 6 capital cities**

- Contributions per capita exceed **120 USD**
- **36 clubs (48%)** have contributed :
 - 23 for \geq 1000 USD
- **36% of clubs** have contributed to **Annual Funds**, 12% communicated their objectives
- **17 clubs** have contributed to **PolioPlus**

Observations from weak clubs

60% of clubs have less than 20 members

Membership	% of clubs in district
From 41 to 50	1%
From 31 to 40	3%
From 21 to 30	36%
From 16 to 20	28%
From 10 to 15	24%
Less than 10	8%

- Uninsufficient information about Rotary and its Foundation
- Uninsufficient knowledge among club leaders
- Uneven support to the Rotary Foundation
- Low incentive to Leadership
- Lack of involvement from senior leaders

- Successful literacy in Gabon during 10 consecutive years
- Creation of a public library in Rwanda
- Cataract surgery in Burundi
